The Faulkner County Quorum Court met in its regular session at 6:00 PM on August 16, 2022 in Courtroom "A" located in the Faulkner County Courthouse with Judge James Baker presiding.

Approval of the Journal:

Justice Higgins moved that the Journal of Proceedings be approved as presented and such motion was seconded by Justice Shock. The journal was unanimously approved.

County Officer's Report:

Treasurer, Scott Sanson, reported to the Court on the financial status of the County and a copy of the report was provided to all members and one is on file.

Standing Committees Report:

The Court discussed Proposed Ordinance 22-40. This is an appropriation Ordinance to amend and supplement Faulkner County Ordinance 21-45, and declare an emergency. Justice Higgins made a motion to accept Proposed Ordinance 22-40 and such motion was seconded by Justice Allison. Counsel Murphy read Proposed Ordinance 22-40 by title only. After discussion Judge Baker asked for a voice vote, the roll was called, and Proposed Ordinance 22-40 passed with a voice vote of 11-0.

The Court discussed Proposed Ordinance 22-42. This is an appropriation Ordinance for law enforcement officer salary stipends for full-time law enforcement officers in accordance with act 224 of the 2022 Fiscal Session of the Arkansas Legislature, and to amend and supplement Faulkner County Ordinance 21-45, and to declare an emergency. Justice Pickett made a motion to accept Proposed Ordinance 22-42 and such motion was seconded by Justice Higgins. Counsel Murphy read Proposed Ordinance 22-42 by title only. After discussion Judge Baker asked for a voice vote, the roll was called, and Proposed Ordinance 22-42 passed with a voice vote of 11-0.

The Court discussed Proposed Resolution 22-09. This is a Resolution calling for a new water source to aide Conway Corporation and the citizens that receive water from Brewer Lake. Justice Higgins made a motion to accept Proposed Resolution 22-09 and such motion was seconded by Justice Roland. Counsel Murphy read Proposed Resolution 22-09 by title only. After discussion Judge Baker asked for a voice vote, the roll was called, and Proposed Resolution 22-09 passed with a voice vote of 11-0.
