NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF FAULKNER COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

Ordinance 2013-03 is amended to read as follows:

- ARTICLE 1: It is in the best interest of Faulkner County, County elected officials, and retired employees, that they participate in the County's Health Insurance program.
- ARTICLE 2: In addition to other eligible persons the following persons are eligible to participate in the County health insurance program, at the person's own expense, provided that the person meets all other eligibility requirements for the health insurance program:
 - A. Former Faulkner County elected officials.
 - B. Former and current Justices of the Peace.
 - C. Authorized volunteers including Faulkner County Emergency Squad and Faulkner County Sheriffs Office Reserves.

- D. Former Faulkner County employees who:
 - a. Have at least 5 years' active County employment, or
 - b. Are retired and receiving County retirement benefits, or
 - c. Who have suffered a disability as determined by the Workman's Compensation Commission.
- ARTICLE 3: Regarding the aforementioned persons, in order to participate and remain eligible the following requirements must be met, in addition to all other County health insurance program eligibility requirements:
 - A. The person must complete and maintain the required documentation with the County Clerk's office; and,
 - B. Payment of the premium must be made at the person's expense and must be made in a timely manner.
- ARTICLE 4: This Ordinance shall not operate to terminate eligibility for any person who is currently participating in the County's health insurance program.
- ARTICLE 5: The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared separable and if any section, phrase, or provision shall for any reason be declared to be invalid, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the sections, phrases, and provisions.
