Dispose of old, outdated, unusable pesticides from your farm free of charge and in complete confidentiality.

WHAT IS ACCEPTED?

Both known and unknown wastes will be accepted, including outdated, discontinued, or unwanted agricultural pesticides (insecticides, herbicides, and fungicides); of particular interest are older pesticides known to be more toxic, such as arsenicals, DDT, silvex, heptachlor, dieldrin, lindane, toxaphene, and 2,4,5-T.

WHAT IS NOT ACCEPTED?

Explosives and ordinance; petroleum products, paints, medical wastes, radioactive substances, household pesticides and chemicals. If unsure, contact your county Farm Bureau or Extension office.



CONFIDENTIAL PROCESS

Holders of old pesticides who plan to participate must fill out an inventory form to register for the collection. The forms are for planning purposes only and strict confidentiality is maintained. Inventory forms are available at your county Cooperative Extension and Farm Bureau offices. Completed forms should be returned to the county Farm Bureau.

This free disposal opportunity is made available through funding from the Arkansas Abandoned Pesticide Trust Fund in cooperation with Arkansas Farm Bureau, The Arkansas Natural Resources Commission, the University of Arkansas Cooperative Extension Service, and your county government.
